AMHERST, OH – After twenty-one years serving as Executive Director of The Nord Family Foundation, John Mullaney announced his plans to retire effective June 2019. During his tenure at the Foundation, Mr. Mullaney helped steer three generations of Nord family members as well as numerous non-family trustees to serve as stewards of the Foundation’s mission and endowment. While at the helm, Mr. Mullaney watched The Nord Family Foundation’s endowment blossom from \$73 million to nearly \$170 million in assets, and annual distributions increase from \$2 million to \$7.5 million.

After several months deliberating a succession plan, The Nord Family Foundation Trustees are happy to announce that Anthony Richardson will serve as the Foundation’s next Executive Director.

We express our profound gratitude to Mr. Mullaney’s leadership and look forward to working with Mr. Richardson in fulfilling the Foundation’s mission for many years to come.

The Nord Family Foundation is a successor to the charitable trust originally established by Walter G. Nord in 1952. The predecessor organization contributed more than \$12 million to a variety of charitable causes between 1953 and 1988, primarily in Lorain County, Ohio. The Nord Family Foundation has contributed more than \$126 million to nonprofit organizations in northern Ohio and selected geographic areas of family interest.
